Cameron

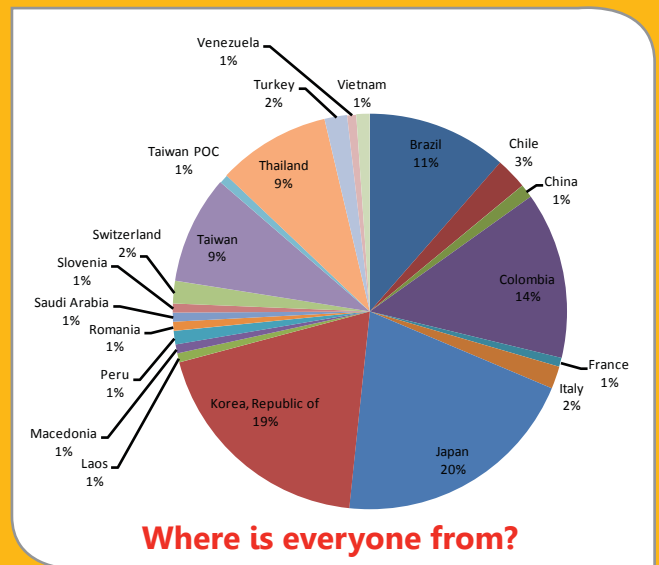
